

PROGRAM

Morning Session:

"I Haven't Got Time For This Pain!" - Local Anesthetics and Analgesics and Their Clinical Considerations

Objectives:

- Discuss local anesthetic agents with respect to their mechanisms of action, adverse effects, contraindications and clinical considerations
- Explain the rationale for the use of vasoconstrictors and potential adverse effects
- Describe the pharmacology and mechanism of action of analgesics used in the management of acute dental pain, including situations that may preclude their use
- Describe techniques useful in recognizing and identifying potential opioid addiction and current protocols for treatment

Afternoon Session:

"Every Pill You Take...I'll Be Watching You!" - Successfully Interpreting Patients' Complex Medication Histories

Objectives:

- Interpret complex medication lists and understand the dental implications of commonly prescribed drug classes
- Develop strategies to obtain complete and accurate medication histories from patients, including their self-medication with over-the-counter drugs and supplements
- Correlate medications with underlying medical conditions to support accurate risk assessment and comprehensive treatment planning
- Recognize polypharmacy and high-risk combinations that may impact dental treatment planning or require medical consultation
